The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 14.10.2015, vide which direction was issued to decide the legal notice of the petitioner by way of passing a speaking order.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Amit Bamby, Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport corporation, Patiala dated 22.2.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the said reply, legal notice of the petitioner was considered by way of passing a speaking order dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure R-1), vide which, the petitioner was found to be entitled to overtime allowance. It is further stated that some amount is released to the petitioner and the balance shall be released within a period of three months.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, in case, the balance amount is not released within a period of three months, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition.
