AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 03.10.2013 passed by this Court in CWP No.9373 of 2008.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Vikram, IAS, Additional Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad filed in the Court, is taken on record. Copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in

pursuance to the directions of this Court, total 25 illegal constructions were earmarked in the disputed area, out of these, 14 constructions have been completely demolished and 11 have been demolished partially. He further states that there is a ban on construction and demolition in the National Capital Region, needful would be done for remaining 11 illegal constructions, within two weeks when the ban would be lifted.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

However, in case grievance of the petitioner still survives with regard to illegal construction in the said area, it would be at liberty to approach the respondent by moving a representation which shall be duly considered.

Since the main case is disposed of, the application for impleadment has rendered infructuous.
