AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

In pursuance to the last order, Mr. Pankaj, Deputy Commissioner, Mewat (Nuh) is present in court. He tenders an unconditional apology for not being present on the last date of hearing, which is accepted.

Short reply dated 20.9.2019 by way of affidavit filed in Court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per pleadings in the reply, an enquiry was conducted and the complaint filed by the petitioners was found to be false.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that though pleadings are there in the reply, but no order has been communicated to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that order will be

communicated within two weeks from today. He further submits that the costs imposed vide order dated 9.7.2019 would be deposited in Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh within two weeks from today and seeks time to recover the same from the defaulting official(s) after following due procedure of law.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the said order.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Let the costs be deposited within two weeks. There is no doubt that action against the defaulting official(s) for recovery of the costs would be taken by the department as expeditiously as possible.
