The contempt petition is filed pleading that directions issued on 04.09.2012 by this Court in CWP No. 15225 of 2012 have not been complied with. Finance Secretary-cum-Principal Secretary, Haryana was to ensure that no school was established/allowed to function in violation of the provisions of Section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (for short '2009 Act') as well as the provisions of Haryana School Education Act, 1995 and Rules framed thereunder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a list of 26 schools operating in District Amabala was given to the respondent stating that these schools are functioning in violation of 2009 Act yet no action has been taken.

Learned State counsel submits that issue with regard to the said 26 schools will be looked into expeditiously and if so, required action, in accordance with law, would be initiated before the start of the next academic session, provided that there are no legal impediment.

Disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
