The present contempt petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is filed pleading non-compliance of judgment of this Court dated 14.2.2017 in CWP No. 3295 of 2011. The grievance is that interest awarded and commuted value of pension have not been released by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents places reliance upon a table giving details of the payment in para No. 3 of the affidavit dated 27.2.2019, he states that interest amounting to ₹ 2,78,043/- has been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that calculation of the interest and the amount due is not correct and representation dated 3.4.2019 was moved by the petitioner, same is not decided yet.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Raj

Kumar Verma, Assistant in the Office of Director, Food & Supply Department, Haryana submits that decision on the representation would be taken within six weeks from today. In case, amount is found due to the petitioner, the same would be paid immediately.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, it is clarified that in case the petitioner is aggrieved of the order passed on the representation, she would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
