The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 17.04.2017, vide which, direction was issued to respondent No.2 to verify whether the persons who were appointed in the year 1981 and whose services had not been terminated, such of those persons' services were regularized. In that event, the petitioner was also entitled for benefit of regularization.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Raj Kumar, IFS, Deputy Conservator of Forests filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, the services of the petitioner has been regularized w.e.f. 01.10.2003. Copy of the same has been placed on record as Annexure R-1, vide which, Divisional Account Branch is directed to ensure that the payment of arrears shall be made as per entitlement.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, in case the respondents do not make the good payment towards the arrears within eight weeks from today, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition and in case the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition, heavy penalty shall be imposed upon the respondents.
