The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 23.02.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 4387 of 2018.

Learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of an affidavit of Kumar Amit, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Patiala annexing report dated 17.07.2019 as Annexure R-2. The same are taken on record. Copy thereof, has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of report dated 17.07.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, it is clarified that if any grievance survives with regard to the report dated 17.07.2019, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
