Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.308 dated 14.10.2017, registered at Police Station A Division, District Amritsar City, under Sections 307, 336, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (subsequently Sections 326, 325, 324 and 323 of the IPC have been added).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner, who is named as Veeru in the FIR, is stated to be armed with pistol and fired from the same on the complainant.

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Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that the complainant has not suffered any fire-arm injury. She also submitted that the complainant has given the statement that there is no injury on his leg.

The petitioner has been in custody since 05.10.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
