The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.79 dated 26.08.2018, registered under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC, at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala.

The petitioner was married with deceased Narinder Kaur on 04.04.2018. Unfortunately, she died on 26.08.2018 by strangulation in the house of her father. However, it was written on her arm regarding 15 lakh rupees, car and another word Noorpur.

It has been submitted that the parents of the petitioner have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Heard. The petitioner is the husband of the deceased. He has to explain the circumstances and he cannot be granted the concession of anticipatory bail even if his parents have been granted bail.

This court is of the view that in this case custodial

interrogation of the petitioner is necessary.

As such, finding no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail, the instant petition stands dismissed.
