The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 20.4.2018, vide which direction was issued to decide the complaint dated 13.3.2018 within a period of three months.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the matter was compromised between the parties, vide which Vikramjeet Singh s/o Dilbag Singh gave his undertaking to marry the petitioner in November, 2018. However, November, 2018 has passed still Vikramjeet Singh has not solemnized marriage with the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid fact, this Court does not find any willful contempt at the behest of respondent-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur. The fact remains that in view of the above development, the complaint still requires to be looked into afresh. Accordingly, the respondent is directed to look into the complaint and in case, any offence is made out, the respondent is directed to take further action or else pass a speaking order, which the petitioner is at liberty to challenge in case still

aggrieved.

The present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
