The present petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of direction of this Court dated 16.11.2017 passed in CWP No.26232 of 2017.

The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondent to release the pension and other pensionary benefits due to the husband/father of the petitioners(in the writ petition). The writ petition was disposed of directing Executive Officer, Municipal Council Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.10.2017.

On 10.1.2019 learned State counsel took time to have instructions. Thereafter, reply dated 3/16.8.2019 was filed annexing order dated 2.8.2019.

As per the said order, it is stated that the family pension has already been started and arrears of pension w.e.f. 19.3.2017 to 30.6.2017 were paid vide cheque No.143084 dated 10.8.2018 and there are no other outstanding arrears. It has further been stated that even the son of the petitioner has been employed on compassionate basis.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not contradicted the said fact.

As there is substantial compliance of direction of this Court, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case still aggrieved of the surviving grievance.
