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**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)**

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that the order dated 27.04.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 10108 of 2015 has been wilfully disobeyed. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

*“Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed with a direction to the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner forthwith by giving parity of treatment with those who continued in service and received orders making them permanent.”*

Learned State counsel has filed the reply on behalf of respondent No.2 alongwith Annexure R-1 in court, today. The same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Satbir Singh, Deputy Superintendent, DFO, Jhajjar submits that the petitioners have been regularized, procedure with regard to the consequential benefits is going on and the payment shall be made within six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the fact that the petitioner has been regularized.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of, as infructuous.

However, in case the above-said statement made by the respondent(s) is not adhered to, petitioner would be at liberty to revive the petition, the same would be at the cost and responsibility of the defaulting official on whom cost may be imposed.
