AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 30.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.1920 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the above said representations (P-6 & P-7) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any of the order (s) passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall

be at liberty to approach this Court or to have recourse to other remedies available under the law.”

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply was filed.

In compliance of order dated 23.04.2019, Mr. Anand Mohan Sharan, Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Urban Local Bodies Department, is present in the Court. He states that the Assistant concerned who had kept the file with him and not communicated about the proceedings, has been suspended and recommended for charge-sheet. He ensures that action shall be taken as per law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that grievance has been redressed partly. He seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of rest of the grievance.

The contempt petition is disposed of, with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
