The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 29.1.2018.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Shamsheer Singh, District Elementary Education Officer, Kaithal dated 14.3.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the said reply, the cost stands paid to the petitioners. Each case of the petitioners stand decided separately by way of passing a speaking order dated 8.5.2018 (Annexure R-1). The petitioners, those who have given their options, their claim has been considered and amount due to them has been paid. Those, who have not given their options, their cases have been dismissed in default.

In view of the above, no contempt is made out, The present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

At this stage, learned counsel for the State submits that since their cases have been dismissed in default for not exercising their options, those such petitioners may file their options within two weeks from today along with the name of the juniors with whom they are seeking step up of

In case, the said options are exercised within two weeks, the respondent shall thereafter pass an appropriate order accordingly.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they have not been paid interest on the delayed amount. If it is so, the petitioners shall file representation seeking interest on the delayed amount, in case they are entitled to, which shall be considered by the respondent within one month from the receipt of the said representation and decided in accordance with law.
