AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 24.09.2016 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.34168 of 2016.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“This petition is disposed of, at this stage, with a direction that Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar will inquire into the matter at his own level, in the representation Annexure P-8 submitted on behalf of Sarvhitkari Adhyatmik Kendra. In case of any such representation having not been received in the said office, it will always be open to the petitioner to submit a fresh petition expecting that the grievance of the petitioner will be fairly looked into, in the interest of maintenance of peace and tranquility in the society, within a period of three to six months.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Chahal, IPS, SSP, SAS Nagar, Mohali was filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of reply filed, no cause of action survives to pursue the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
