At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no interest has been paid.

In case, the petitioner is not paid any interest, she is at liberty to avail remedy as available to her for claiming interest in accordance with law. Further in case, the amount so mentioned in the sanction order is not paid by 1.8.2019, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition. In case, the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition, the respondent shall also be liable for a heavy penalty of ₹ 50,000/-
