This petition has been filed for quashing of complaint No.17180 of 01.08.2017 and summoning order dated 09.11.2017 as well as impugned order dated 18.10.2018.

The impugned order declining to set aside the summoning order has been passed on the ground that the revision was belated. The revisional court found that the petitioner had appeared through counsel on 05.03.2018 and filed the revision on 01.08.2018 without even an application for condonation of delay.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in fact the petitioner had come to know of the summoning order only on 31.03.2018 and not on 05.03.2018. Even this aspect has been considered by the revisional court because from this date also the revision is belated.

Resultantly, no ground for interference is made out. Petition is

dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
