AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

These two contempt petitions are filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 30.11.2016 passed in bunch of writ petitions, main being CWP No.13563 of 2016. Both the contempt petitions are being disposed of by a common order as similar issues are involved.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of annexure appended with the reply filed, claims of the petitioners

have been rejected. The grievance raised is that rejection is on the basis of letter dated 24.01.2018 but the same is not annexed by the respondent. It is further submitted that respondent has erred in placing reliance on the letter dated 24.01.2018.

The contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner cannot be gone into the contempt petition. There is substantial compliance of directions of this Court i.e. decision to be taken with regard to promotion of the petitioners.

The contempt petitions are disposed of.

The respondent is directed to supply letter dated 24.01.2018 to the learned counsel for the petitioners within two weeks from today. The petitioners shall be at liberty to move representation to the respondent within two weeks from receipt of the letter. The representation shall be considered by the respondent in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

In case petitioners are aggrieved of order passed by the respondent, they shall be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
