Short reply by way of affidavit of Dalip Singh, HPS DSP, Badhra on behalf of the respondent filed in Court is taken on record.

Petitioner, who is facing trial for offences under Sections 395, 397 and 420 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, in FIR No.368 dated 4.10.2016 registered as Police Station City Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri, seeks interim bail for two weeks from 7.1.2019 to 20.1.2019 to attend marriage of his sister fixed for 13.1.2019.

Notice was issued to the State. State has submitted the documents. It is conceded that marriage of sister of the petitioner is fixed for the said date. However, at the same time, it is brought to the notice of the Court that petitioner is also facing trial in another case under Section 379-B, 341 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act. He is stated to be a member of a Gang. It is stated that previously, petitioner got interim bail from Delhi High Court stating that marriage of his sister is fixed for 13.12.2018. The said case is stated to be pending at Delhi. It goes to show that third case is also pending against the petitioner under Section 302 IPC.

State has further taken a stand that the petitioner is a gangster and opposes his release on interim bail stating that he is likely to abscond.

Considering that petitioner is wanted in three serious cases, there is every possibility of petitioner fleeing justice, if he is released on interim bail. However, in order to enable the petitioner to attend marriage of his sister which is to be solemnized on 13.1.2019, the petitioner is ordered to be taken in custody under proper security arrangement to # 119, Kakrola

Near Barat Ghar, New Delhi-78 on 13.1.2019 at 5.00 P.M and allow to attend the marriage and after attending wedding ceremony, he be either kept in nearby jail/ police station or brought back to the jail.

Both petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
