The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 19.5.2017.

Affidavit of compliance dated 17.5.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the said affidavit, the order has been complied with. The arrears have been paid from 27.2.2004 up till 17.12.2015 i.e. is the date of his retirement and thereafter, arrears have been paid from 17.12.2015 along with interest @ 9% per annum. The petitioner is being continued to pay pension thereafter as per the calculation.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed. The order dated 6.3.2019 issuing bailable warrants against the respondents is accordingly recalled.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case, there is any discrepancy in the amount so paid by the respondents, the petitioner will be at liberty to file a representation bringing out the discrepancy along with calculation within a period of 15 days from today. The respondents shall consider the said representation in accordance

with law within another 15 days of the receipt of the said representation. In

case, the petitioner is found due to any amount, the same too shall be paid within another 15 days thereafter.
