The present contempt petition has been filed alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 04.12.2017 of this Court passed in CWP No. 24873 of 2017.

The relevant part of the order is reproduced below:-

“In view of the limited prayer raised by counsel and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition at the very threshold with directions to respondent no.2 i.e. the Chief Engineer, Irrigation Department, State of Punjab/competent authority to proceed further in the matter in accordance with law and to take a final decision on the application dated 22.8.2016 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Reply filed by respondent.

Learned State counsel states that in compliance of order of this Court, an order dated 08.10.2018 has been passed.

In view of above, no further action is called for in the contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

The rule issued against the respondent is discharged.

Needless to say that petitioner can avail remedies in accordance with law in case he is aggrieved of the order dated 08.10.2018.
