In pursuance to the last order dated 11.3.2019, additional affidavit of Amarjit Singh Gill, Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation, Division No.2, Hoshiarpur dated 18.4.2019 along with the detail of the principal amount as well as percentage of interest with respect to each of the petitioners, has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the calculation but disputes that the amount has been paid to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State prays four weeks time to ensure that the amount is deposited in account of the petitioners.

Time as prayed for is granted.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, in case, the amount is not deposited in account of the petitioners within the period as mentioned above, they are at liberty to

revive the contempt petition. If the petitioners are forced to revive the contempt petition, the responsible respondent shall personally be liable for penalty of ₹50,000/- to each of the petitioners.
