The present contempt petition has been filed for disobedience of the order dated 19.02.2016 passed in CWP No.17294 of 2015 read with order dated 20.05.2016 as passed in C.M. No.6279 of 2016.

Sekhu, Deputy Director (Administration) states that CPF amount due to the petitioners has since been deposited with the Treasury under New Pension Scheme (NPS).
