Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the pleading in reply filed that the investigation has been completed in both the FIRs and Challan has been produced in FIR No. 133 dated 15.10.2014 registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka. Further in FIR No. 150 dated 15.10.2014 registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Mukatsar Sahib, cancellation report has been filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that liberty be granted to avail remedies in accordance with law against the cancellation report. He further seeks liberty to avail remedies for the harassment having been faced by the petitioner.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives for pursuing

the contempt petition. The present contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
