Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.599 dated 15.09.2018, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 14.01.2019 in the main case, passed the following order:-

“ Learned senior counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the entire evidence is documentary in nature and is already in possession of the police. The petitioner is an aged lady of about 63 years. It is a family dispute and infact the petitioner had paid a sum of Rs. 20 lacs to the family of the complainant on account of the land in dispute.

Notice of motion for 01.04.2019.

The petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 21.01.2019 at 10.00 a.m. and co-operate therewith. In the event of her arrest, she shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to her joining the investigation and compliance of the provisions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, A.S.I. Virender Singh, who is present in the Court, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 14.01.2019 and her custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 14.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
