The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 12.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 2625 of 2012. The writ petition was allowed and official-respondents were directed to undertake the determination of seniority etc. in the light of the observations.

Pursuant to the notice of motion, a reply has been filed annexing the seniority list.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the above reply, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if some grievance survives.

With regard to petitioner No. 4-Ajay Bhardwaj, he states that the case has not been considered.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Naveen Kumar, Superintendent, H.C., Sectt, Irrigation and Water Resources Department states that in order to promote petitioner No. 4, eight persons already working needs to be reverted. The said procedure has been started and they are being providing the opportunity of hearing. He further submits that needful would be done within three weeks from today. Thereafter, the case of petitioner No. 4 would be considered for promotion as it depends upon the outcome of the entire process.

The contempt petition is disposed of in above said terms. However, there is no doubt that needful with regard to petitioner No. 4 be done expeditiously i.e. the proceedings initiated against 08 persons for reversion would be concluded within three months from today and thereafter, if certain benefits accrues to petitioner No. 4, the same would be given immediately.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
