The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 02.05.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 10804 of 2018 and other connected matters. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“4. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 17.2.2018 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.”

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 has placed on record a short affidavit of respondent No.1 annexing order dated 19.07.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of order dated 19.07.2019, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, it is clarified that if any grievance survives with regard to the order dated 19.07.2019, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
