The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 9.10.2017 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 10.8.2017 with respect to the interest to be paid to him on the compensation awarded in pursuance to the award Nos. 41 and 43 dated 1.12.2016.

Learned counsel for the respondents prays for time stating that they do not have the details of all the petitioners.

Mr. Ashok Kumar, Patwari, Office of Land Acquisition Collector, Gurugram is present in person. It is stated by him that he will be satisfied that in case the petitioner hand over the copy of the petition as well as the copy of the award for him to work out the interest amount due to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is dismissed with a direction to the petitioner that copy of the petition alongwith the copy of the award with the forwarding letter be given in the Office of Mr. Ashok Kumar, Patwari present in the Court within two weeks from today. Mr. Ashok Kumar, Patwari shall give the receipt of the delivery of the petition and award to the petitioner and thereafter necessary order with respect to the interest shall be passed within four weeks thereafter and after calculating the interest, the amount shall also be paid to the petitioner within another four weeks of the same, in case, he is found entitled to the such interest otherwise speaking order be passed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
