The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 15.3.2018, vide which the respondents were directed to reinstate the petitioner and grant all consequential benefits to her.

With respect to the argument that enquiry was required to be completed within six months, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Sh. Suresh Pal, E.HM, Government Middle School, Teh Brahman, states that enquiry has since been completed and the enquiry report has been finalized.

The said enquiry report be handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner within two weeks from today.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
