AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging that HUDA (now known as HSVP) land was encroached upon and any illegal construction have been raised on the public property including the area in front of the house of the petitioner. The writ petition was disposed of by directing the Estate Officer, Panipat to get the demarcation carried out in the presence of the petitioner as well as the persons in whose favour some land appears to have been released. Further it was directed that Administrator, HUDA, Rohtak and Estate Officer, Panipat shall ensure that construction shall be permitted only as per the zoning plan.

The contempt petition was filed pleading that needful has not been done.

A short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Yogesh Ranga, Estate Officer, HSVP, Panipat, filed today, along with receipts of depositing of Rs. 12,000/- costs, are taken on record. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that on one occasion, when the petitioner was present but demarcation could not be done as there was construction and the khasra number was in *zig zag* form. Thereafter, demarcation was done by way of digitalization on 06.09.2019 and the demarcation of the site has been annexed as Annexure R-4 in the shape of a map.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that petitioner is satisfied with the digitalized demarcation but states that apart from the map, a report be provided so that remedies in accordance with law may be availed for redressal of the grievance of the petitioner, if any.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Sh. Yogesh Ranga, EO, HSVP, Panipat, submits that the report shall be supplied within three weeks from today.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
