The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 12.9.2017, vide which direction was issued to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in accordance with rules and regulations.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the petitioner is found only dependent to late S. Harnam Singh and therefore, is being entitled for family pension on the basis of the Dependent Certificate. It is further stated that the sanction has also been received and the amount will be deposited in the account of the petitioner within one month.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.

It is clarified that in case the amount is not deposited within one month from today, the petitioner will be at liberty to file application for revival of the contempt petition and the respondents shall also have to pay another ₹ 50,000/- as penalty.
