Main Case

Similar Contempt Petition No.2630 of 2018 as well as other
connected contempt petitions have been disposed of by this Court vide
order dated 21.2.2019 which reads as under:

“However, in case, the petitioner(s), is still aggrieved in any manner,
they are at liberty to file representation to the respondents within four
weeks from today placing on record the proof of the wages or the
pay scale which was being granted to them. The respondents shall
consider the same and pass a fair order within one month of the
receipt of the said representation after hearing the petitioner(s). In
case, the petitioner(s) is found entitled to the pay scale as claimed by
them, necessary balance amount shall be paid to them forthwith and

in case, the respondents come to the conclusion that the pay scale as claimed by the petitioner(s) is incorrect, a speaking order shall be passed, which the petitioner(s) will be at liberty to challenge in accordance with law.”

In view of the above, the present petition is also disposed of in the above terms.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
