Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.0149 dated 23.11.2018 registered under Sections 304 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, on the basis of settlement.

In the present criminal case, petitioners-Doctors are alleged to have caused death of Baljeet Kaur at the time of birth of two twin children due to medical negligence.

Notice of motion was issued. Mr. Naveen Batra, Advocate had appeared on behalf of respondent No.2.

On 19.08.2019, first informant Mandeep Singh was present and admitted that there is a settlement between the parties, however, adjournment was sought on the ground that respondent No.2 has some dispute with his own father-in-law. Today, no one is present on behalf of

respondent No.2.

Keeping in view the fact that on 19.08.2019, parties have already made a statement that there is a settlement between the parties, therefore, the present petition is disposed of and FIR No.0149 dated 23.11.2018 registered under Sections 304 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are ordered to be quashed, on the basis of compromise, however, qua the petitioners only.
