These three contempt petitions have been preferred pleading

COCP No.2909 of 2018 (O&M) and connected matters -2-

2018, dated 4.5.2018 passed in CWP No.11120 of 2018 and dated 22.03.2018 passed in CWP No.7157 of 2018 have not been complied with.

The respondent was directed to take conscious decision on the legal notices particularly in the light of the Circular Nos.17/90 dated 23.04.1990, 62/92 dated 16.12.1992, 52/99 dated 9.11.1999 and 20/2000 dated 28.07.2000, the decision was to be taken within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed the replies and are taken on record. Copies of replies are handed over to the counsel for the petitioners. Learned counsel states that direction of this Court has been complied with and order passed on legal notices. The claims of the petitioners have been accepted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) states that though the claim has been accepted still grievances survive, as no payments have been received.

The claim of the petitioners has been accepted, the respondent shall disburse the dues within reasonable time.

No further interference is called for in the contempt petitions.

If petitioners still have some grievance, they would be at liberty to avail their remedies in accordance with law.

The contempt petitions are disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
