The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 17.07.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 15338 of 2017. The operational part of the order is quoted below:

*“Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, Parivar Kalyan Bhawan, Sector 34-A, Chandigarh to consider the claim of the petitioner within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, that too, particularly in view of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 13114 of 2016 (O&M), titled as “**Joginder Kaur v. State of Punjab and others**” decided on 19.05.2017 including the grant of interest on the delayed payment. In case, petitioner is entitled to the aforesaid benefits, to release the same within a period of two months thereafter.”*

A reply by way of an affidavit of Dr. Jaspal Kaur, Director, Health & Family Welfare, Punjab filed in Court today, is taken on record. It is stated that the payment of the medical reimbursement after verification has been made.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner on the last two occasions. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
