Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.262 dated 26.12.2017 registered under Section 354 of IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deeds dated 17.01.2018 & 15.12.2018 (Annexures P-2 & P-4 respectively).

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Farminder Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has prepared cancellation report.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition and seeks withdrawal, however, with liberty to

file fresh one in case cancellation report is not presented to the Court or the same is not accepted by the Court.
