The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.129, dated 28.11.2018, registered under Sections 406/420 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Banga, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Punjab.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press this petition and the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail but the same be directed to be decided expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed and it is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on 15.03.2019 and moves an application for regular bail, the same be decided in accordance with law expeditiously but in any case on or

before 19.03.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
