The contempt petition is filed for non compliance of the order dated 28.2.2018 passed in CR No. 7662 of 2016, which was disposed of with direction to the respondents to take a decision with respect to the claims within six months and till such time the plots be reserved.

Mr. Deepak Sabharwal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents states that the matter was decided vide order dated 8.5.2018, which has already been challenged by the petitioner by way of a separate writ petition bearing No. 19414 of 2018. It is further stated that the plot stands reserved for the petitioner as on date.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is given to take all the pleas before the Writ Court.

The rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
