Reply filed on behalf of respondent No.3 is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from Shri Anirudh Tewari, Principal Secretary to Government of Punjab, Finance Department, who is present in the Court, states that the amount shall be released to the respondent-Department by 31.3.2019. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3-Department states that the bills have already been forwarded to the State.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction that as soon as the amount is released by respondent No.1-State, respondents No.2 and 3 shall further disburse the same to the petitioner within four weeks from the receipt of the Department.

In case the said amount is not deposited within the stipulated period after release by respondent No.1, the petitioner is at liberty to revive the contempt petition and in case the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition, serious note will be taken.
