The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.90 dated 14.9.2018, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arrested on the disclosure statement of the co-accused and recovery of five injections of Buprenorphine containing 2 ml. was effected which is less than the commercial quantity. The petitioner is in custody since 1.10.2018 and he is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh states that investigation of the case has been completed and although charges have been framed yet no witness has been examined.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody since 1.10.2018

and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant him regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
