Learned counsel for the State submits that they have issued a letter dated 5.12.2018 directing the petitioner to join service at Alewa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no objection in joining at Alewa.

The contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to join at Alewa immediately. The respondents will not put any hurdle in the way of his joining.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have displaced him way back on 11.8.2018, whereas they were supposed to allow the petitioner to continue in service in terms of the interim order dated 23.5.2016 and after passing of the said order they should have given him continuity in service from the date they displaced him. If it is so, the petitioner is at liberty to file representation seeking his continuity in service from the date he was displaced till the date he joins at Alewa, which shall be

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be at liberty to avail remedy available to him in accordance with law.
