The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 28.05.2018 vide which a direction was issued to decide the legal notice dated 25.03.2018.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the communication dated 13.11.2018 vide which the petitioner has been regularized w.e.f. 01.01.1999 and the payment of arrears have been also paid.

It is pointed out that the petitioner has since retired. In that case, if the pension has not been fully disbursed to him, the petitioner may file a representation to the said effect.

However, it is evident that no order has been passed with respect to the allotment of GPF account number to the petitioner for subscription of General Provident Fund.

Accordingly, the respondent is directed to pass an appropriate order for the same as well within one month from today.

The present contempt petition is disposed of with the above.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged. In case, needful is not done as above, the contempt petition is revived.
