After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of the complaint filed by respondent No.7 and other criminal action which has been taken.
