Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.8 dated 14.01.2017 registered under Sections 302 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural (Annexure P4).

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on an earlier occasion, the petitioner has filed CRM-M No.36018 of 2017, which was disposed of on 26.07.2018 on the basis of the affidavit filed by the Assistant Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Shahpur, Jalandhar, wherein it is stated that since the Chemical Examiner report with respect to the viscera of the deceased – Jagir Singh, is pending with CFSL, no further investigation can be carried out and the petition was disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurmej Singh, submits that after completion of the investigation, the police has prepared a cancellation report on 08.01.2019 by the SHO and the same

is now pending approval with the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural) Jalandhar and the same will be presented within a period of 02 months before the Illaqa Magistrate.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of having been rendered infructuous and he may also be granted liberty to raise all the available pleas/defences before the trial Court.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous with liberty aforesaid.
