The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 10.7.2018, vide which, direction was issued to look into the representation dated 12.6.2018 of the petitioner with a direction that in case, the petitioner was found entitled to the amount, the same be released forthwith.

Reply has been filed on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3. as per the said reply, the claim of the petitioner was considered by way of passing a speaking order dated 25.1.2019 (Annexure R-2/1) and the amount due to the petitioner has since been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, pointed out that the respondents were also required to pay the interest on the delayed amount, which has not been done. The speaking order is silent qua the interest part.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed

petitioner qua the interest, on his representation (Annexure P-5) already placed on record, within one month from today, in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.
