This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 19.04.2018 passed in CWP No. 9354 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“ Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 23.12.2017 (P-7) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules, regulations particularly in view of judgment rendered by this Court in in CWP No. 14796 of 2009 titled as **Ved Parkash Jhingan vs. Panjab University, Chandigarh and another**, decided on 24.09.2010 (P-8) as well as LPA No. 1148 of 2011, titled as **Panjab University, Chandigarh and another vs. Ved Parkash Jhingan**, which was dismissed on 13.07.2011 (P-9), within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. ”

On the last date of hearing i.e. 29.05.2019, learned counsel for the respondents stated that the cheque has been sent to the petitioner by post. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has received the cheque.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced the calculation with regard to computation of pension, same is taken on record. Copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

The petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case of any grievance with regard to the calculations.
