The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 28.1.2015.

Replies by all the respondents have been filed. As per reply filed by respondent No.3, the order has been fully complied with and there is no violation of the said order in as much as the direction was to grant fresh appointment to the petitioners and till such time they are adjusted against the vacant posts, the same shall not be filled from out side. Accordingly, there were two vacant posts available and they have already appointed two incumbents, who are from the petitioners' category. No vacancy is available as of now qua the present petitioners. It is further stated in the reply that they shall appoint the petitioners as soon as the vacant posts are made available.

In view of the above and the reply filed by respondent No.3, this Court does not find any willful disobedience of the said order.

The contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
