By this petition, the petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to depute them to intermediate school course.

On notice of this petition, reply has filed by the Additional Director General, Haryana Armed Police, Madhuban on 13.02.2019 and the respondents have placed on record seniority order dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure R-1) with regard to refixation of the seniority. This order has been passed by the Inspector General, Haryana Armed Police and seniority of the private respondents has been refixed in batch No. 61 of lower school course under 20% category as their names were apporoved in lower school course in the year 2014 and they have been sent for intermediate school course. It has further been clarified in the reply that the last candidate in the general category who has been sent for intermediate school course is HC Narender Kumar and his order of merit is 198(a)/1160 and his batch No. is 61 and the order of merit of the petitioner HC Amit Kumar is 295/1160. The merit of the petitioner HC Amit Kumar is lower than the last candidate sent for intermediate school course. The other two petitioners are from batch No. 62 and hence they could not be sent for intermediate school course.

Keeping in view seniority order dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure R-1), this petition is dismissed. However, petitioners are at liberty to challenge seniority order dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure R-1) in accordance with law.
