The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 17.9.2015 passed by this Court in CWP No. 23241 of 2014. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Consequently, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of regularization in terms of the policy 1996. Necessary orders in this regard be passed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and all consequential benefits flowing to the petitioner be released to him within a period of six weeks thereafter.”

Mr. Dharam Pal, Deputy Superintendent, Office of Divisional Forest Officer, Bhiwani, who is present in court has filed affidavit of Rajesh

Arya, Divisional Forest Officer (Territorial), Bhiwani. The same is taken on

record. Along with the reply, order dated 3.8.2019 has been annexed whereby the services of the petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 1.2.1996.

In view of the reply, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

The present petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law if some grievance survives.
