Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.266 dated 13.08.2018 registered under Sections 304-B and 34 of IPC at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the son of the petitioner, namely, Jaideep Sharma, who is about 2 years of age, is suffering from cancer and is still getting treatment from AIIMS Hospital, New Delhi.

Vide order dated 02.04.2019, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner for a period of one month enabling him to take treatment for his son from the hospital.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that Jaideep Sharma is a patient of cancer and requires medical treatment.

In view of above, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witness in any manner directly or indirectly.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
